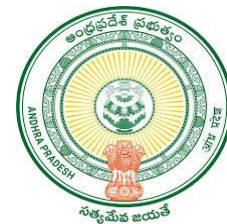

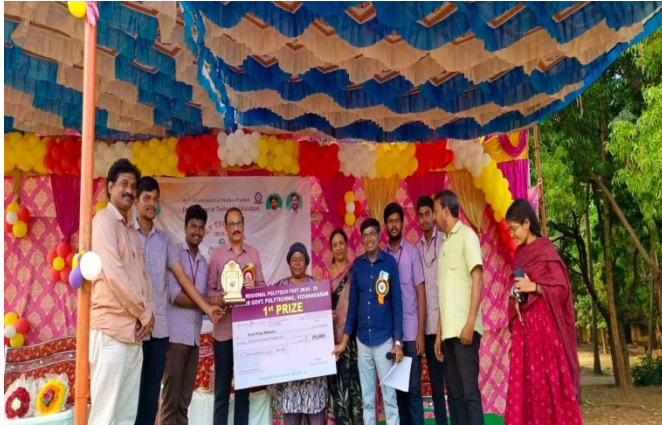


సమాజాభివృద్ధిలో సాంకేతిక పరిజ్ఞానం కీలకం

Instructions to Candidates:

- The candidate is instructed to download the allotment order from <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>
- The candidate is instructed to report by clicking on "Allotment order and Self-Reporting" under "Forms" tab from website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>
- Further the candidate is instructed to take print out of two copies of joining report and allotment order and physically report to the allotted college. Submit a copy of joining report, allotment order and obtain acknowledgement on 2nd copy of joining report from the college where candidate has reported and retain that copy with the candidate.
- The candidate is instructed that self-reporting in portal and physical reporting at the allotted college is compulsory to retain the present allotment. The last date for self-reporting and reporting at the allotted college is **17.07.2025**.
- If the candidate does not report through self-reporting system and/or not physically reporting at the allotted college, the provisional allotment will be treated as a vacancy for the subsequent phase and the provisional allotment of 1st phase of APECT-2025 Admissions will automatically stand cancelled and the candidate has no claim on the seat allotted. Further, if the candidate reports through self-reporting and does not report physically at the college on or before **17.07.2025**, his/her allotment/admission will be cancelled.
- It is informed that the academic credentials verified if found false at a later date, the candidate's allotment will be cancelled and the candidate is liable for criminal prosecution.
- It is instructed that the candidate is not required to deposit original certificates in the college/institute at the time of admission. The candidate can produce original certificates only for the purpose of verification in the college/institute and can submit only Photo copies in the college/institute.
- Further, it is instructed that the candidates who are not eligible for fee reimbursement under the "Post Matric Scholarships (RTI)" Scheme shall pay the tuition fee after final phase only. In this regard, the college managements are instructed not to collect any type of fee from the candidates till the final phase of admissions.
- All the Principals are requested to verify the original certificates viz: caste, study, income, EVWS and Diploma/Degree certificates etc. of the admitted candidates thoroughly and requested to bring any deviation to the notice of the
